In the U.S., in 2018, 40 million children were poor or lowincome. Most of these children are at serious risk from the economic impacts of the coronavirus on their families. Reduced work hours and unexpected medical bills are resulting in tighter budgets, layoffs, hunger, evictions, and foreclosures, increasing the risk of housing insecurity and related health problems.

For many of the 1000+ children in Chicagoland that My Joyful Heart serves, this is the norm, intensified during these last few months. Many restrictions have been placed on businesses, service organizations and lives in general during the COVID-19 pandemic and the difficulties surround us. It is crucial that during these times we continue to trust in God to bring good out of these situations.
